ORDINANCE NO. 9-2001

AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 11-13 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF COMANCHE, TEXAS, AS IS MORE FULLY SET OUT HEREIN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMANCHE:

SECTION 1

That the Code of Ordinances, City of Comanche, Texas is hereby amended by the addition of Section 11 – 13 which shall read as follows:

- (a) It shall be unlawful and a public nuisance for any person, facility, association, corporation, or other entity to create or allow Unreasonable Noise. Unreasonable Noise includes but is not limited to creating any unreasonably loud, disturbing or unnecessary noise of such character, intensity or duration as to be detrimental to the repose, life or health of ordinary reasonable people, including but not limited to, the following specific noises:
 - (1) The playing of any radio, television, phonograph, musical instrument or other sound producing machine in such a manner or with such an unreasonable volume as to disturb quiet, comfort or repose of ordinary responsible people; and
 - (2) The use of any stationary internal combustion engine, air compressor equipment, dynamic braking devise, "jake-brake", motor vehicle, or other power devise, which is not equipped with an adequate muffler in constant operation and properly maintained to prevent any unnecessary noise, and no such muffler or exhaust system shall be modified or used with a cutoff, bypass, or similar devise.

SECTION 2

That Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Comanche shall remain in full force and effect except as amended by this ordinance.

SECTION 3

This ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its date of passage, upon publication in the newspaper as required.
